Paul Kingston:

At Certain steps the order need to make we don't how much effect our actions have on that. During the last four weeks we have been striving as a group and we indicated tonight to be a special meeting. When we looked to be able to accomplish these things it was going to take a tremendous effort and a certain price had to be paid. We realize it had to be a joint effort. Some of the things we are going over we requested members only to this meeting.

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The purpose of that fasting was done so each of us would pit out the striving to lift that weight at the same time. The first fast of that striving consisted of four weeks. Those individuals that chose to do that they could take part and pay that price. All that effort has gone to make these things possible. There are a lot of our people that have had the opportunity of taking part in that striving. The ones that did not take part in that striving, they will never have the opportunity of putting that effort out in that regard again.

From this time on rather fasting each Thursday, we will just fast on the first and third Thursday of each month. The men with numbers are going to be fasting each Thursday. The reason we are enjoying those things because someone else is striving on our behalf. For those that would like to take part in these things will do that as a group on the first and third Thursday.

One of the first things that come in regard to us in our numbers, there were a lot of people that were called and they failed in those responsibilities. Because some of these people failed in those responsibilities some of the responsibilities will have to be taken up by us individuals and the whole plan will be smaller than it could have been. Another thing that is brought regarding here is the opportunity there is for other men to hold those numbers.

We were able today to meet with some of the men with numbers to tell them some of the requirements that were necessary for them to take the responsibilities they should, to live a consecrated life and dedicate their lives in the service of the Lord.

Also the things that were brought in the 1940 meeting by Brother Elden that they may be able to represent the Kingdom of God here upon the earth to all of their fellowmen; have high moral standards and a life of honesty and all those things.

Brother Paul Kingston No.9:

In taking these steps the Lord knows our abilities and qualifications and to what extent we are able to support His work.
